180 Turning Lives Around is the state-designated comprehensive domestic violence and sexual violence agency for Monmouth County. All of our services are free and confidential thanks to your support. Your donations will help us continue to save and change lives:

## <u>461</u>

Individuals were provided domestic & sexual violence counseling to 387 survivors and an additional 74 children enrolled in our Amanda's Easel Creative Arts Therapy Program.

## <u>2,983+</u>

180 answered almost 3,000 calls to our 24/7/365 Domestic & Sexual Violence Hotline.

## <u>592</u>

Individuals provided support at local ERs and police stations to 469 domestic violence and 123 sexual assault victims.



180 provided safe housing to 136 adults, 133 children through our emergency safehouse. Totaling 22,412 bed days.

## <u>1,142</u>

Individuals provided court advocacy and legal assistance at the Monmouth County Family Justice Center.
